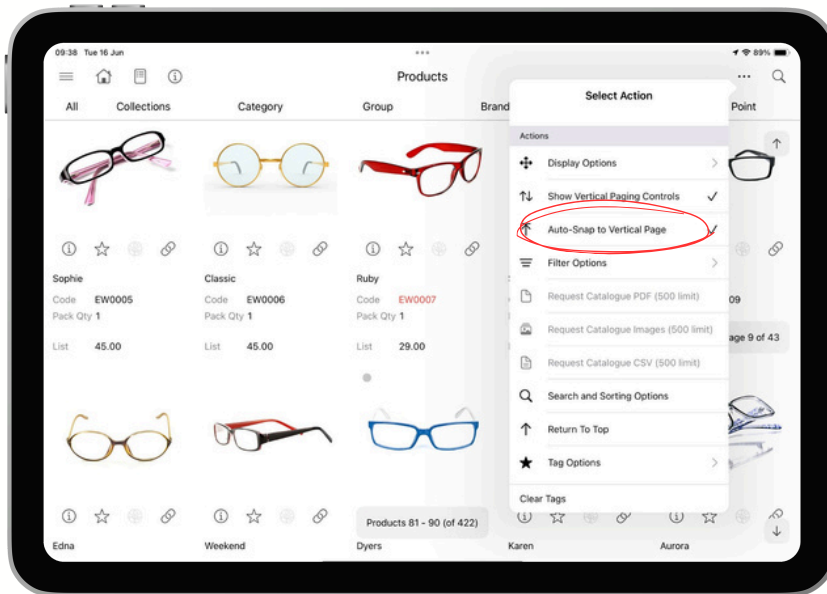


## UPGRADES

### Vertical catalogue scrolling

#### What's changed

- Vertical scrolling on catalogue pages now defaults to free scrolling
- Snap scrolling remains available and can be enabled from Settings if preferred



#### How it helps

Users can browse catalogues more naturally while retaining the option to use snap scrolling

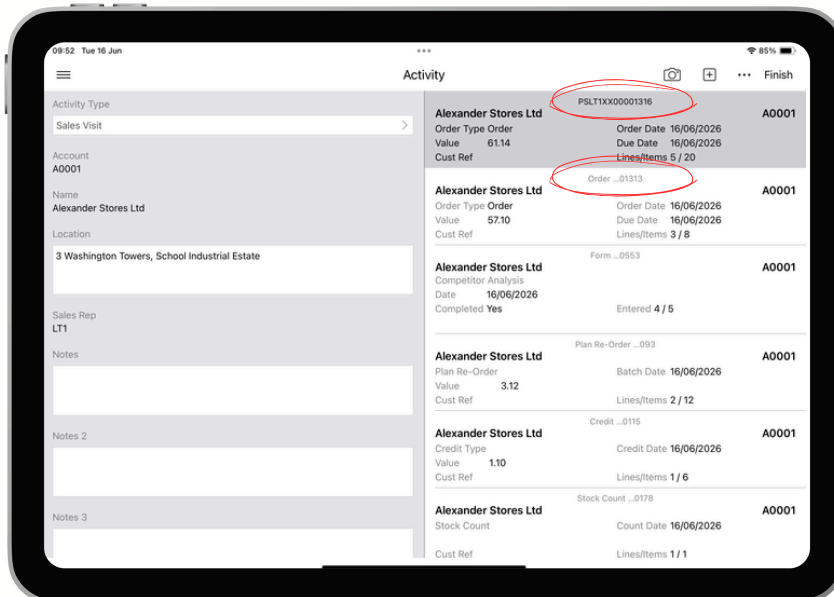
<b>Requirements</b>	No data or configuration needed
<b>Access</b>	Universally available

## UPGRADES

### Activity and Out Tray improvements

#### What's changed

- Activity and Out Tray screens now display the transaction type alongside a shortened transaction reference
- Transaction types such as Orders, Credits and Forms are now easier to identify at a glance
- Tapping a transaction reference will reveal the full reference number
- The display automatically returns to the shortened format after a short period, or immediately if tapped again



#### How it helps

Makes it quicker to identify transactions while still providing easy access to the full reference when needed

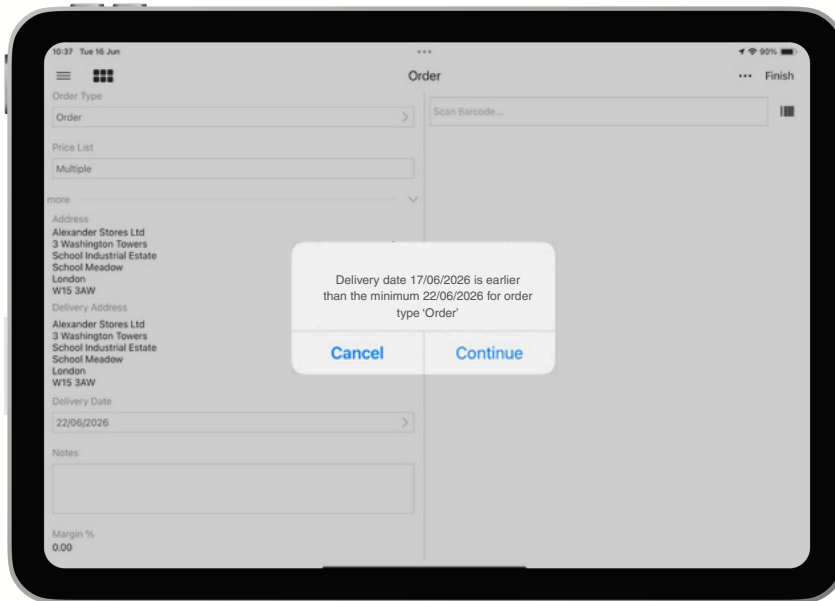

## UPGRADES

### Delivery date configuration

#### What's changed

- New configuration options allow businesses to control whether users can move delivery dates earlier than the default minimum delivery period
- Users can be prevented from selecting earlier dates, shown a warning before proceeding, or allowed to make the change without restriction
- Delivery dates can still be moved further into the future as normal



#### How it helps

Gives businesses greater control over delivery date policies while supporting different operational requirements

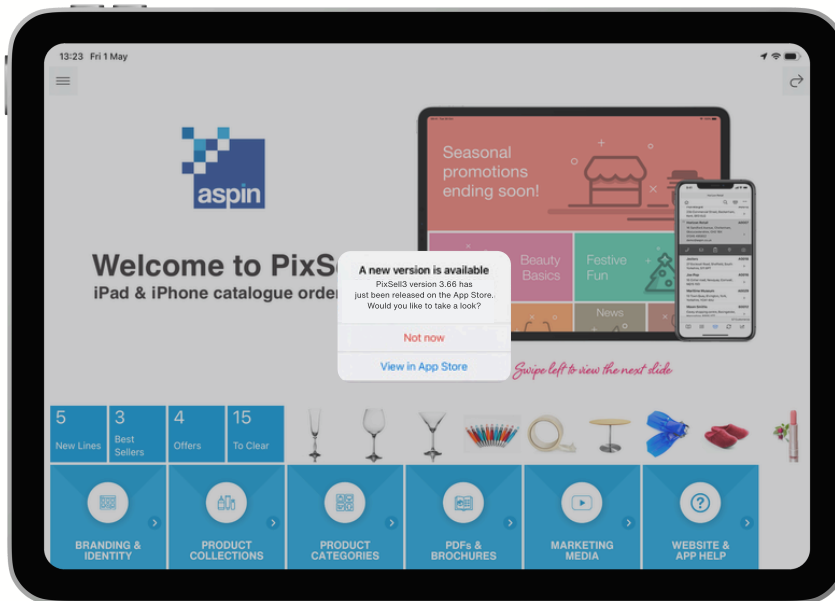

## UPGRADES

### In-app update notifications

#### What's changed

- A new update notification will appear when opening PixSell after a new release becomes available
- Notifications are shown from seven days after release to help users stay informed of the latest updates



#### How it helps

Helps ensure users are aware of new features, improvements and important product updates

<b>Requirements</b>	No data or configuration needed
<b>Access</b>	Universally available

## OTHER IMPROVEMENTS

### What's changed

- Small improvements to Forms interface
- Improvements made to sync performance and messaging

### Bug Fixes - all now resolved

- Popup keypad not always dismissing after a product search
- Product images occasionally freezing during barcode scanning
- Notification badges briefly flashing when a catalogue was first opened
- Saved Advanced Filters could display incorrect sales rep after changes were made in DataBridge
- Sync issue intermittantly preventing large image downloads from successfully completing

## UPGRADE GUIDANCE

### Before you Upgrade

We recommend testing each release on a single device to confirm it works with your workflows before rolling it out across your team. This helps avoid disruption and ensures a smooth upgrade.

PixSell 3 now requires iOS 17 or above, so check device compatibility before upgrading.
